

CPC30220 Certificate III in Carpentry

Description

This qualification provides a trade outcome in carpentry, covering work in residential & commercial applications.

Occupational titles may include:

- ✓ Carpenter – Commercial
- ✓ Carpenter – Formwork
- ✓ Carpenter – Residential

The qualification has core unit of competency requirements that cover common skills for the construction industry, as well as a specialised field of work.

The construction industry strongly affirms that training and assessment leading to recognition of skills must be undertaken in a real or very closely simulated workplace environment and this qualification requires all units of competency to be delivered in this context.

Completion of the general induction training program specified by the National Code of Practice for Induction Training for Construction Work (ASCC 2007) and as per Work Health and Safety Regulation 2011 - Part 6.5 General construction induction training is required before entering a construction work site. Achievement of unit CPCWHS1001/CPCWHS1001 meets this requirement.

Packaging Rules

To achieve this qualification, the candidate must demonstrate competency in:

34 units of competency:

- 27 core units
- 7 elective units.

Some units in this qualification may have prerequisite requirements, which must be met when packaging the qualification. Users are referred to the list of CPC units with prerequisite unit requirements available in this Training Package for this purpose.

Enrolment Options

We currently offer this qualification as:

- an Apprenticeship over 48 months (expected completion 42 months) or
- RPL assessment only with a maximum duration of 3 months.

Commencement Requirements (RPL)

Please consult with your local authority to ensure you are eligible and meet other criteria prior to commencing studies with Building Industry Training. After the completion of this qualification, it is recommended that the student undertake an Approved Managerial Course for Trade Contractors or Certificate IV in Building and Construction.
